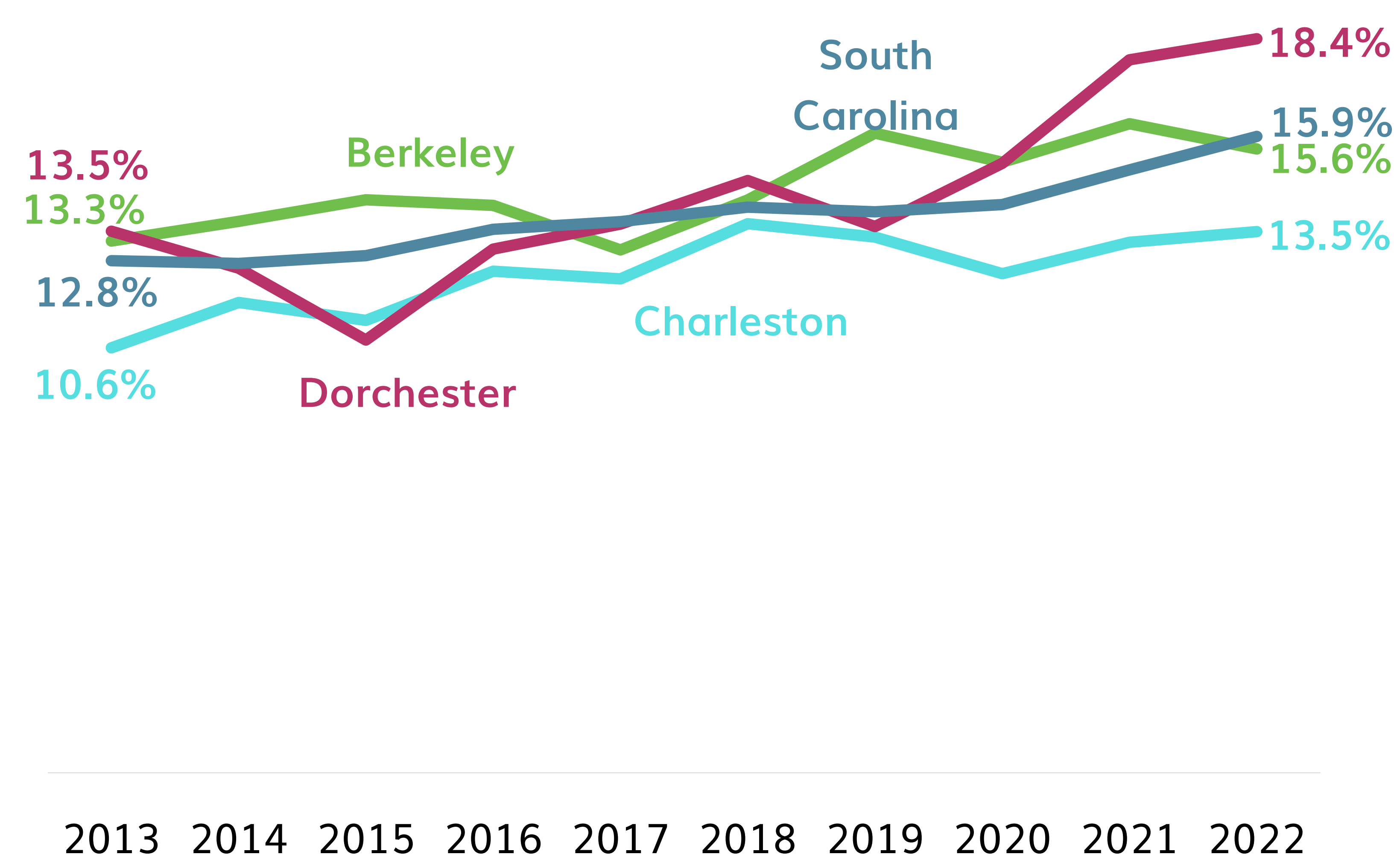

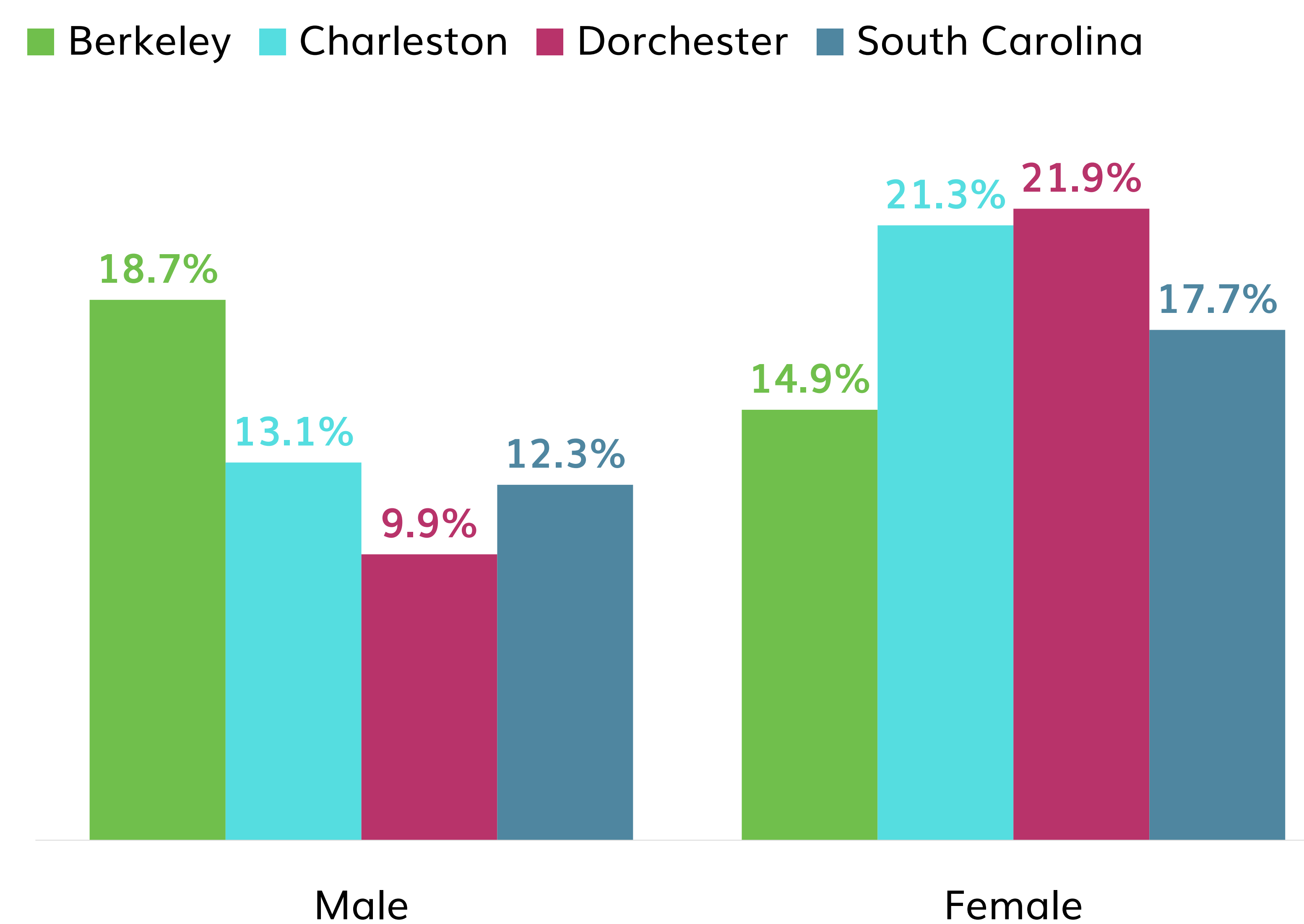
Adults Who Experiences 14 or More Poor Mental Health Days in the Past Month

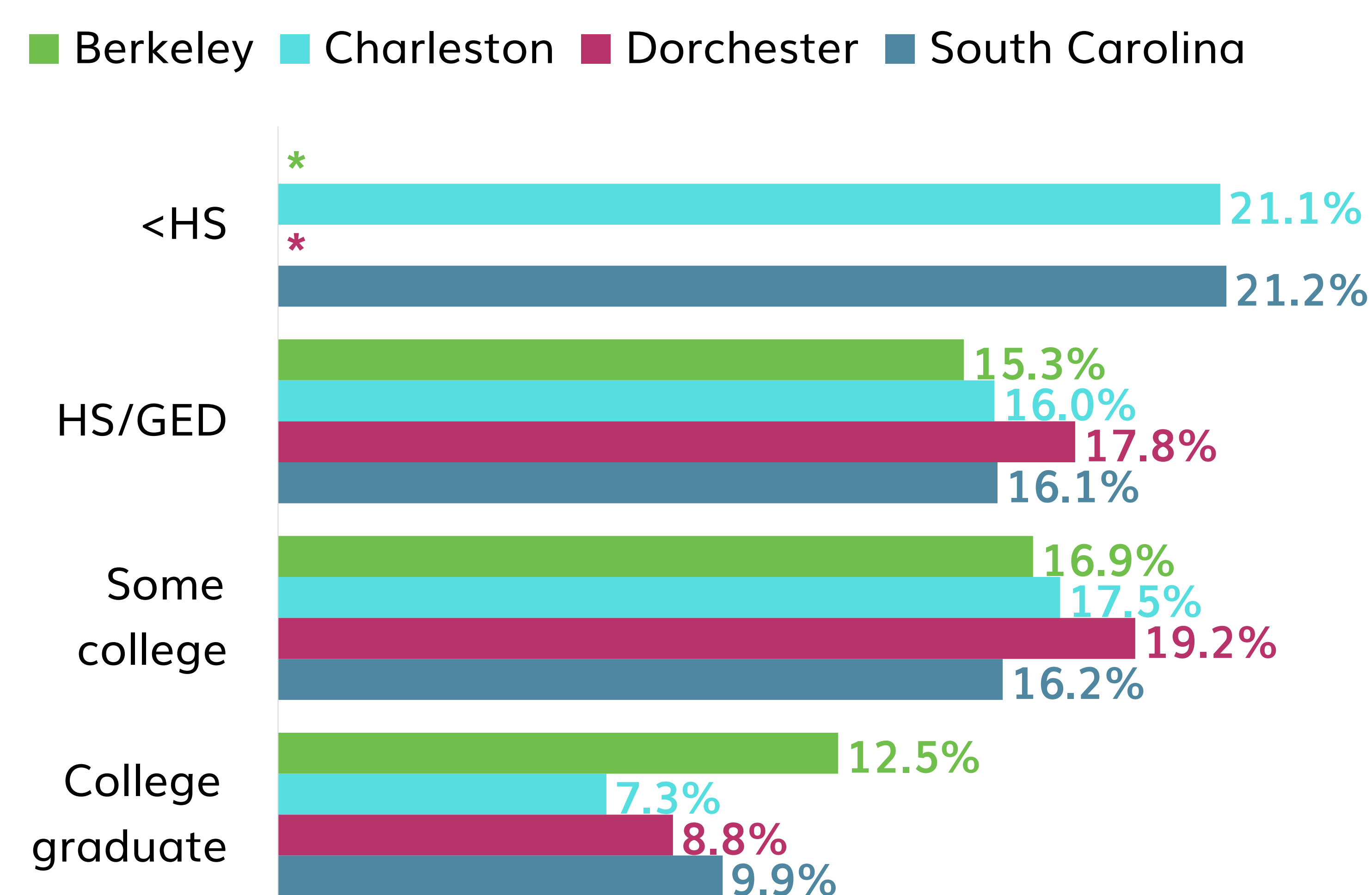

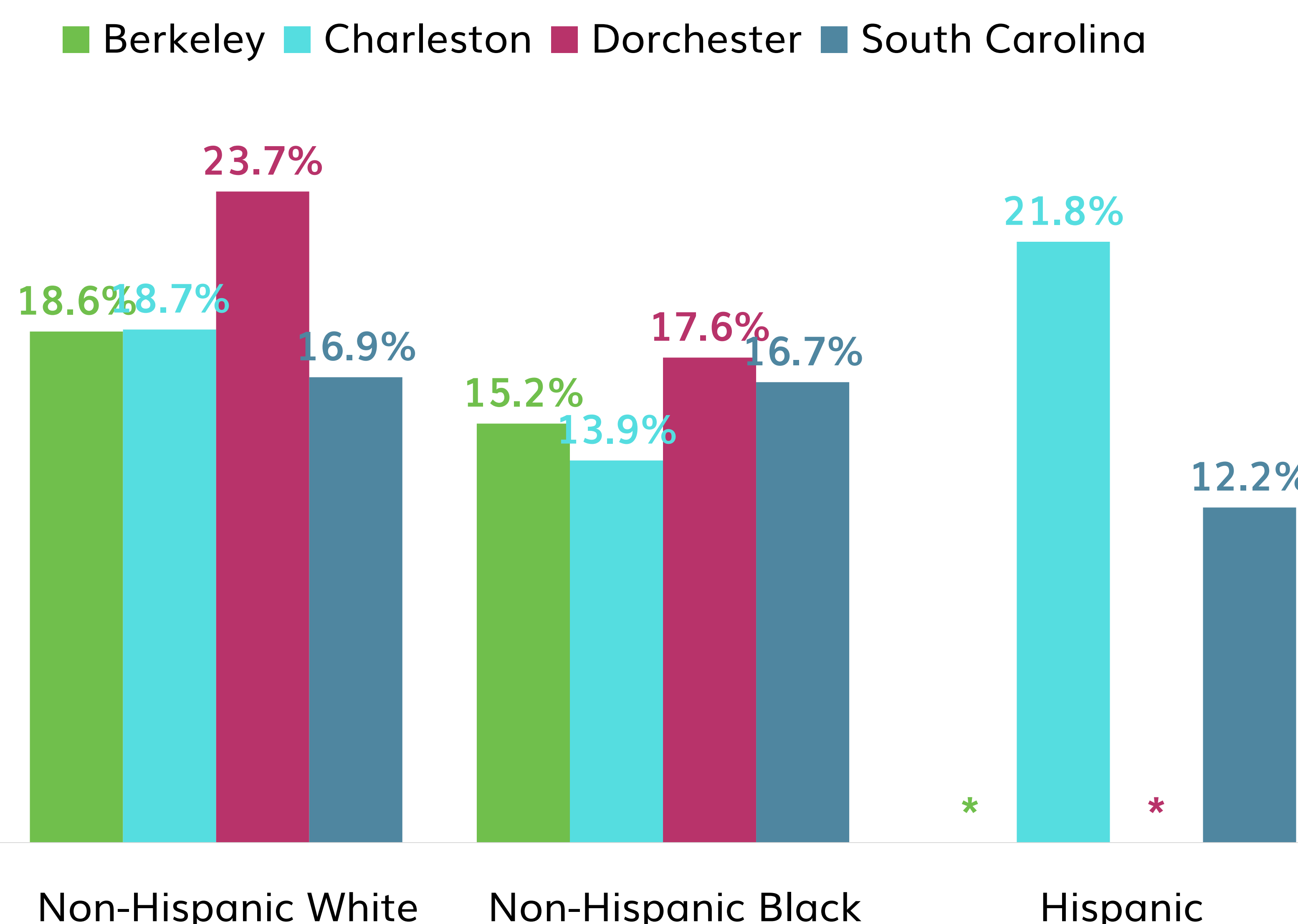

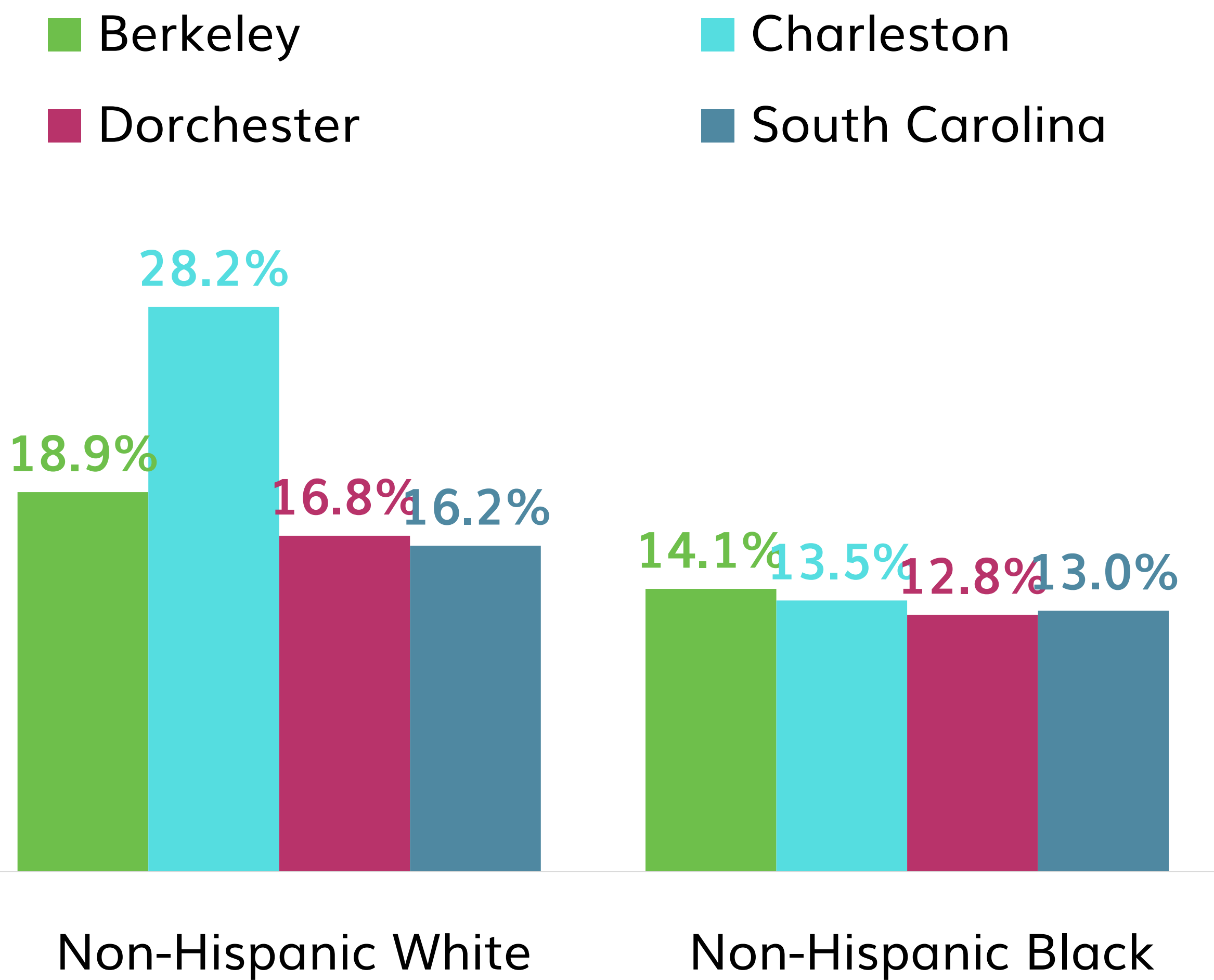

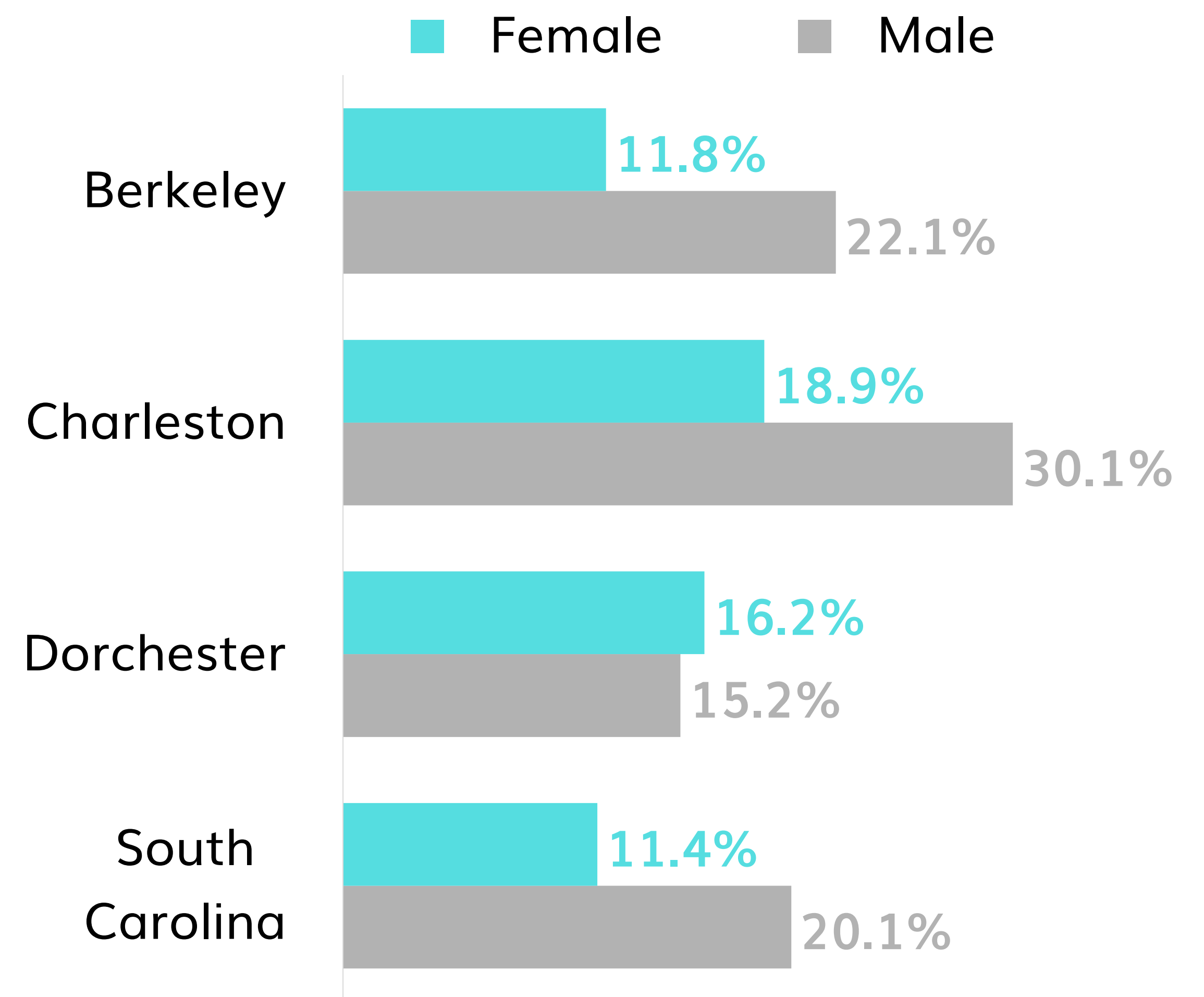

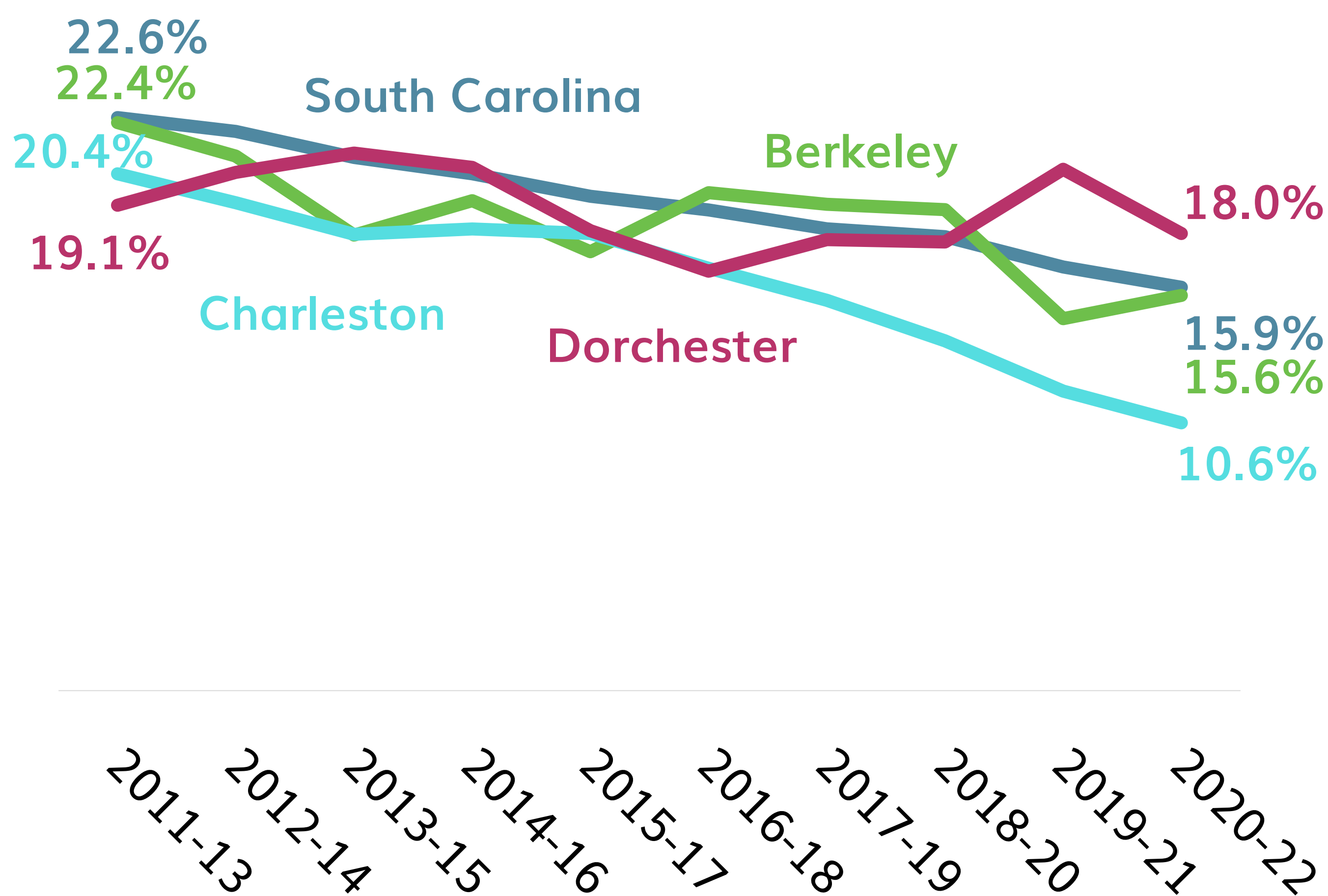
Binge Drinking, by Sex

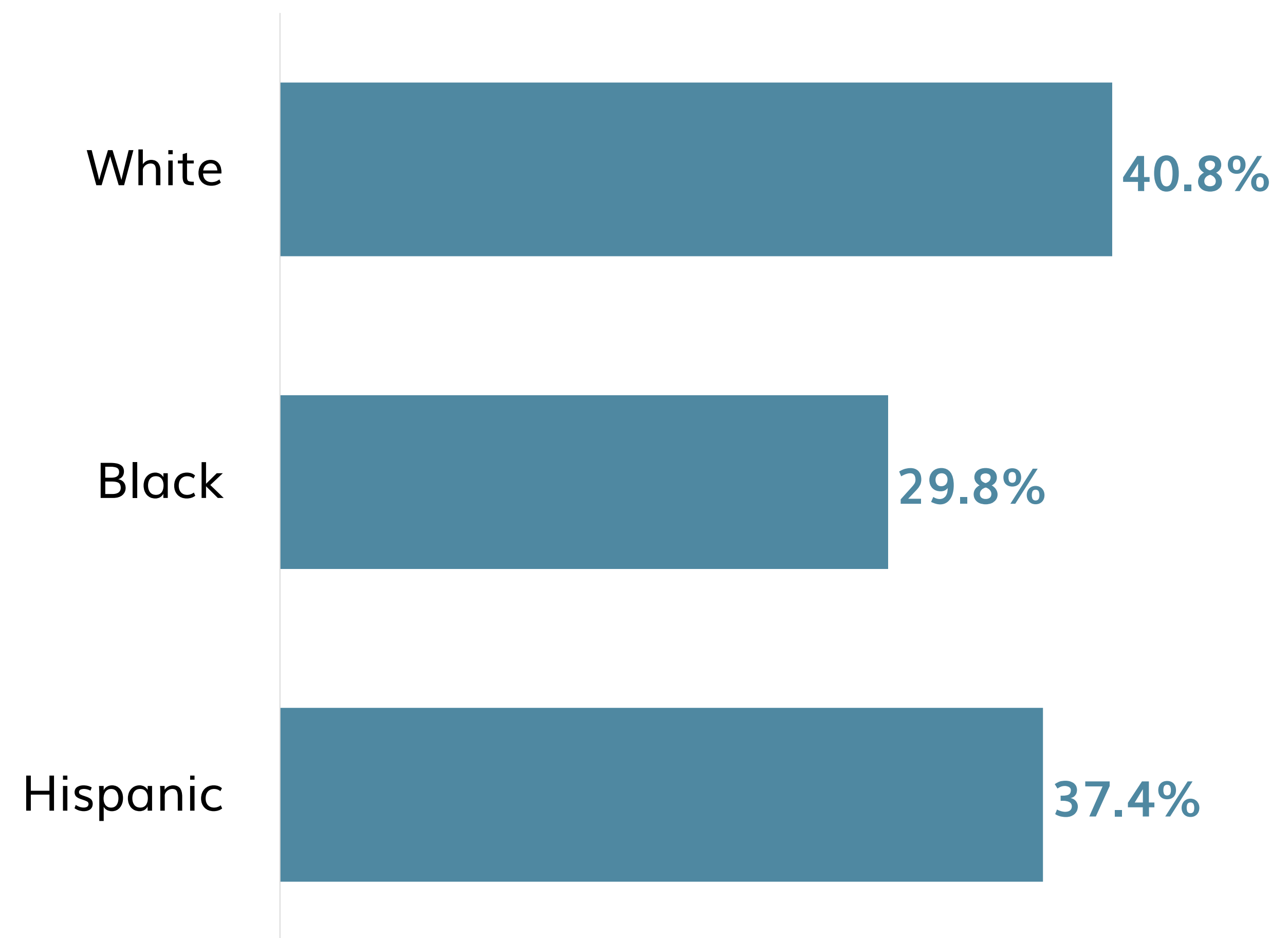
Tobacco Use

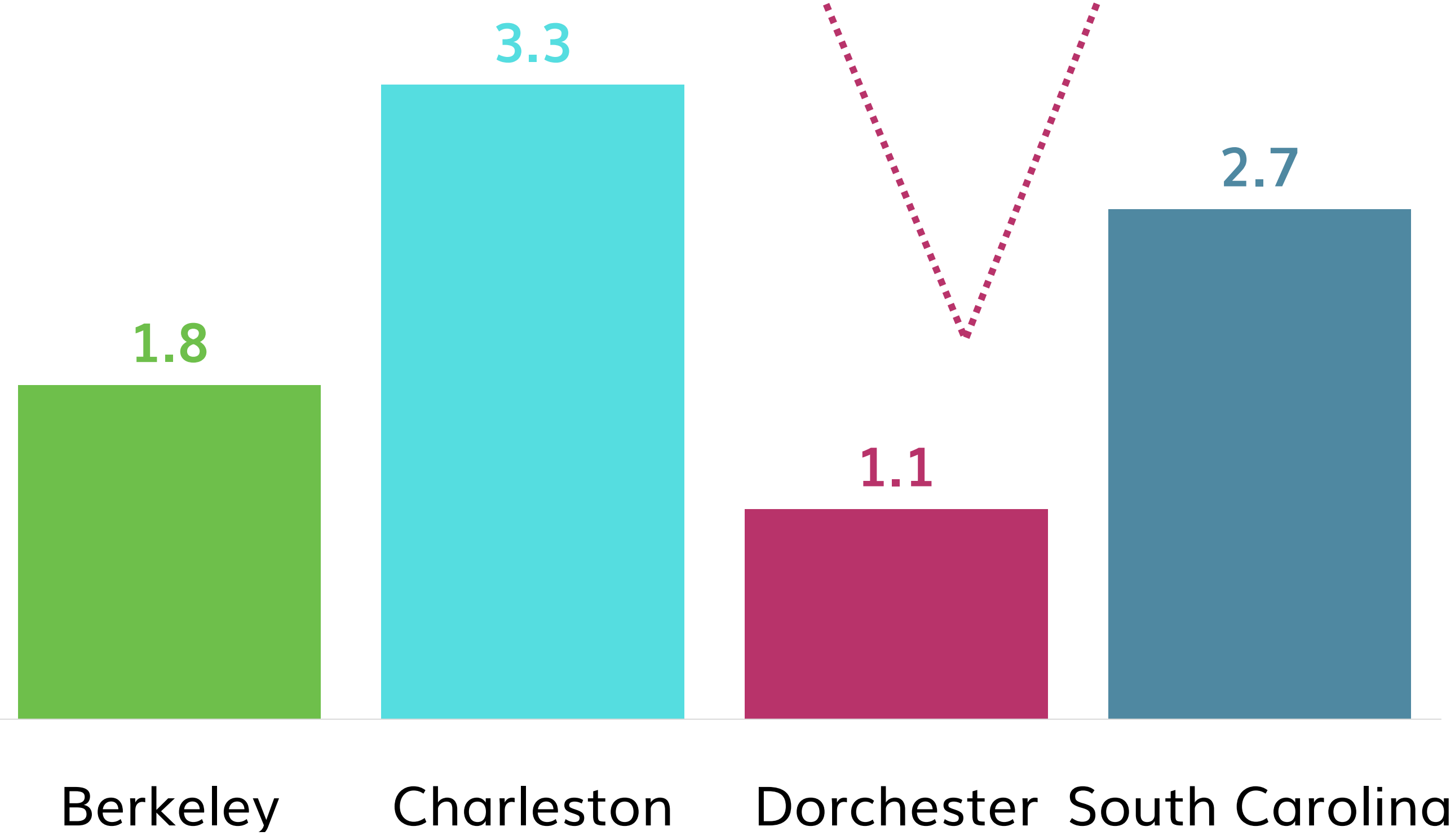

Rate per 1,000 population

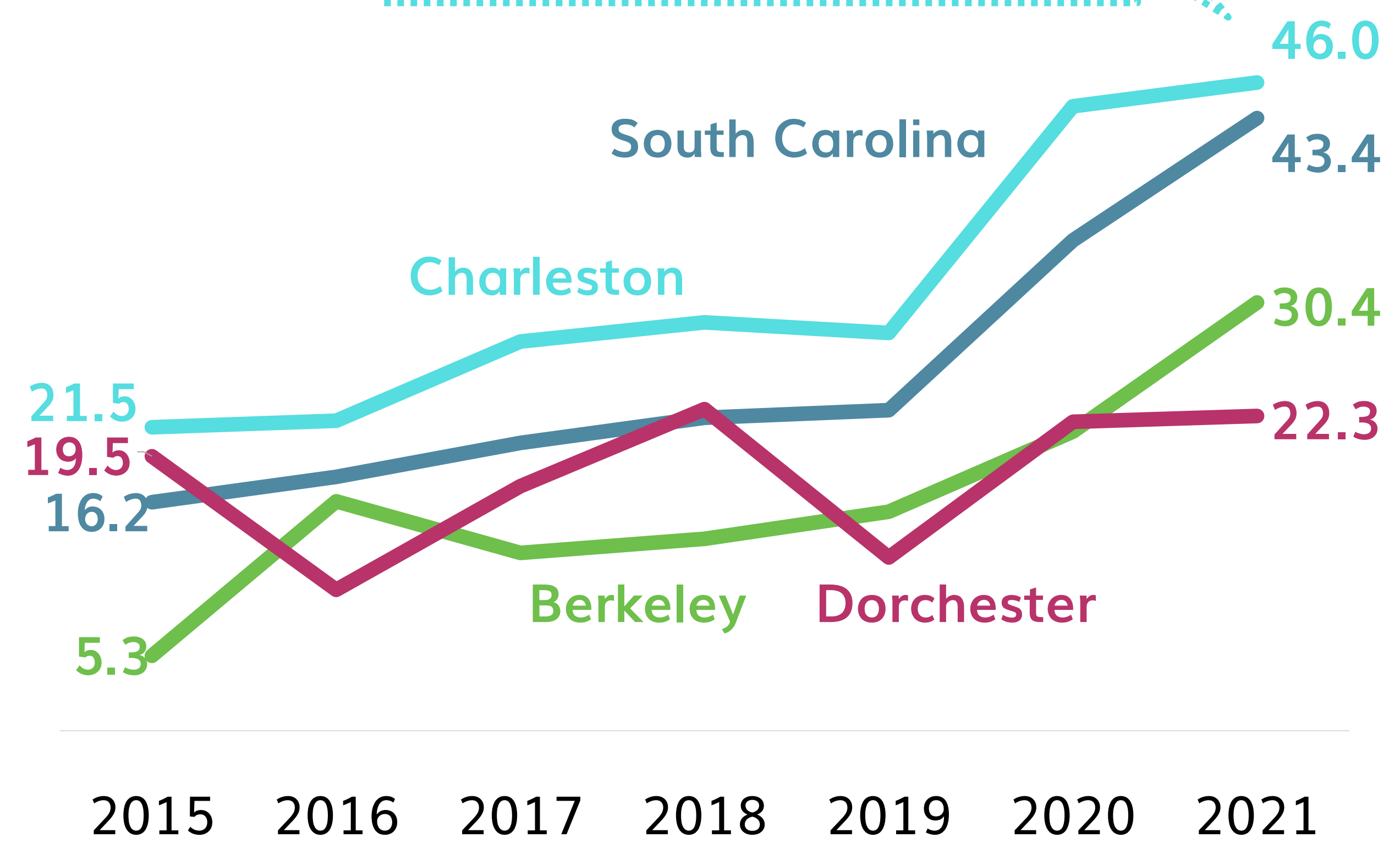
In 2022, Dorchester County had the 4th lowest rate of Naloxone administrations in the state while Charleston County had the 13th highest rate.

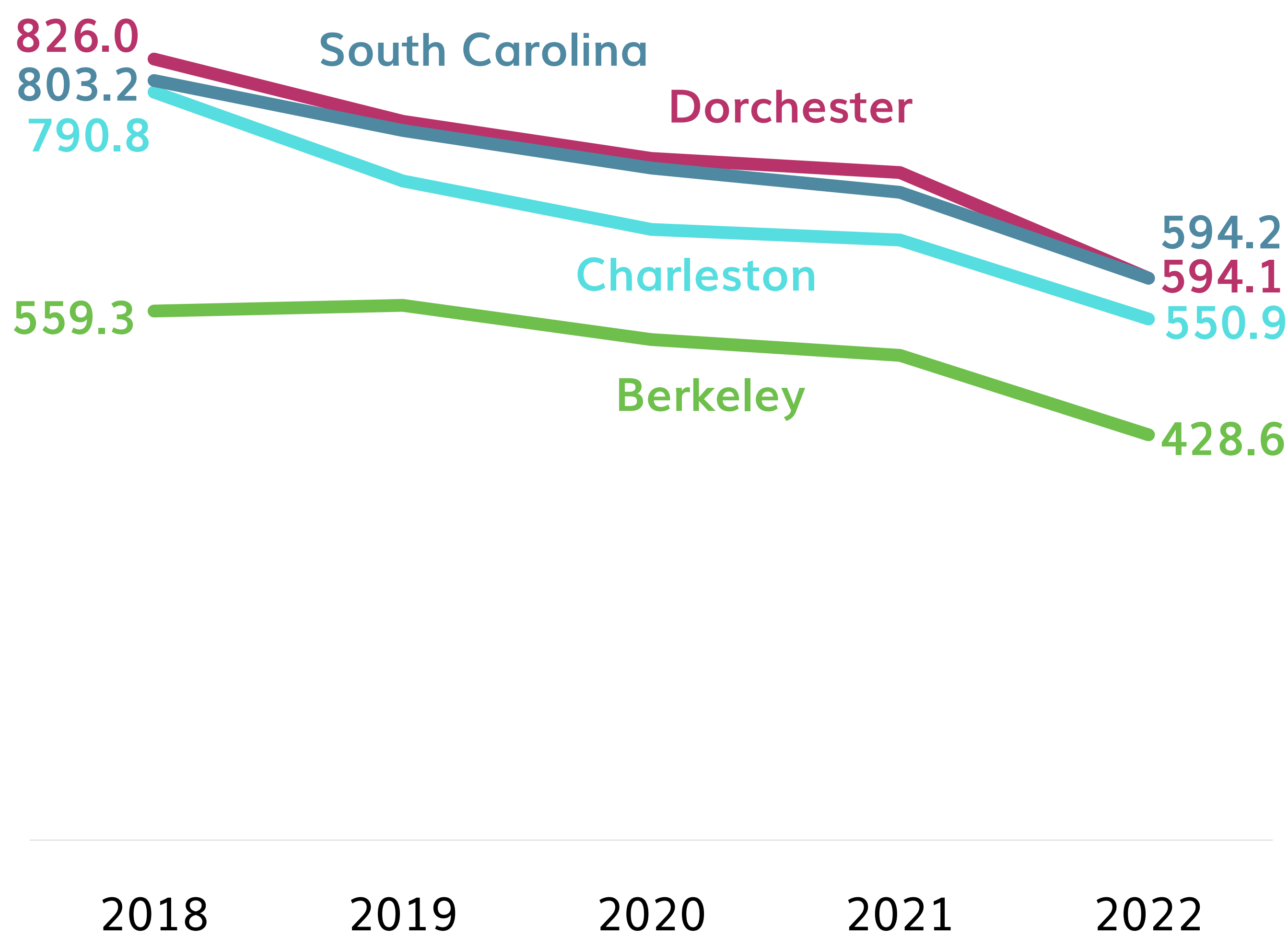
Drug Overdose Deaths

In 2022, Charleston had the 16th highest rate of drug overdose deaths in the state.



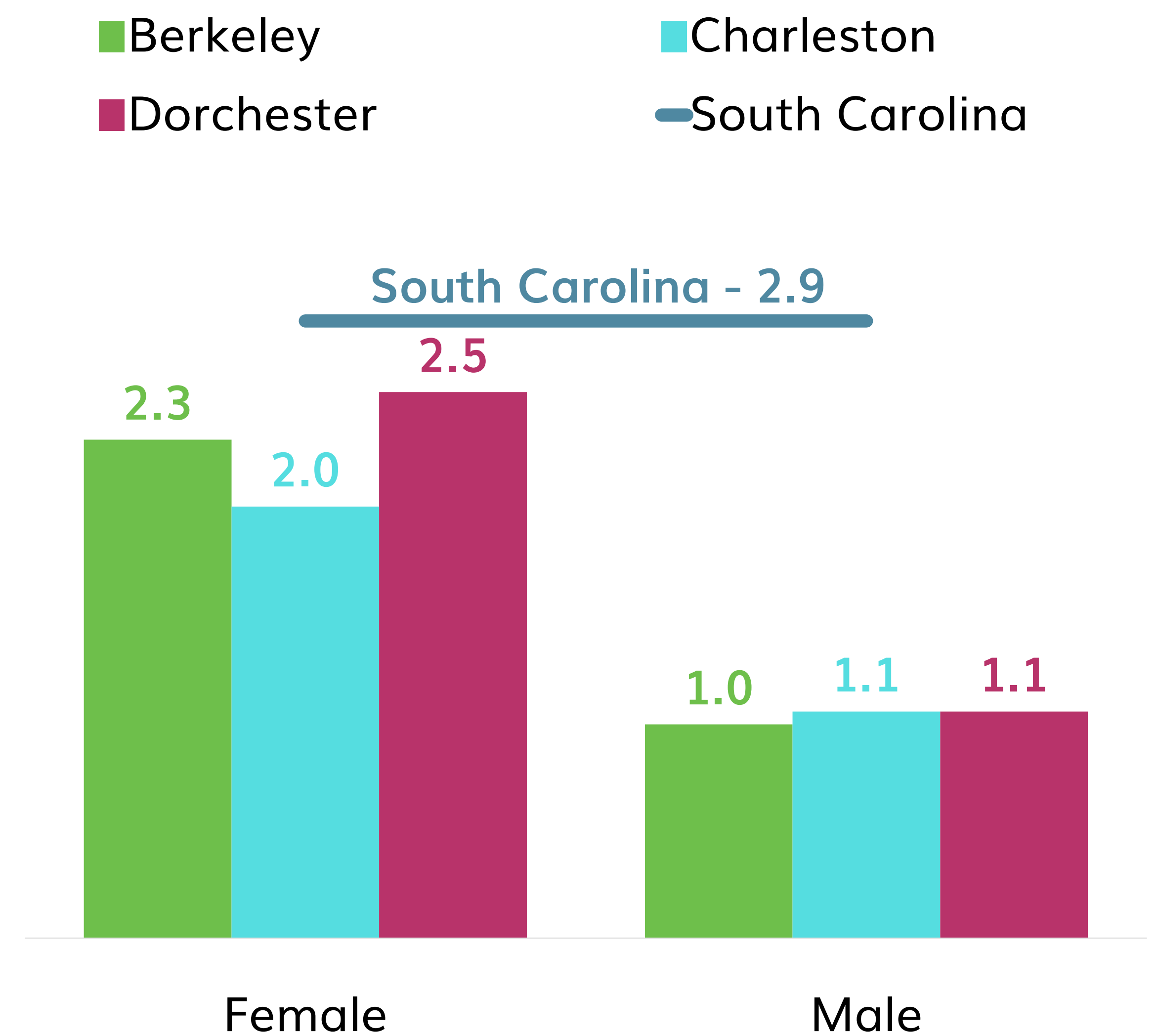
