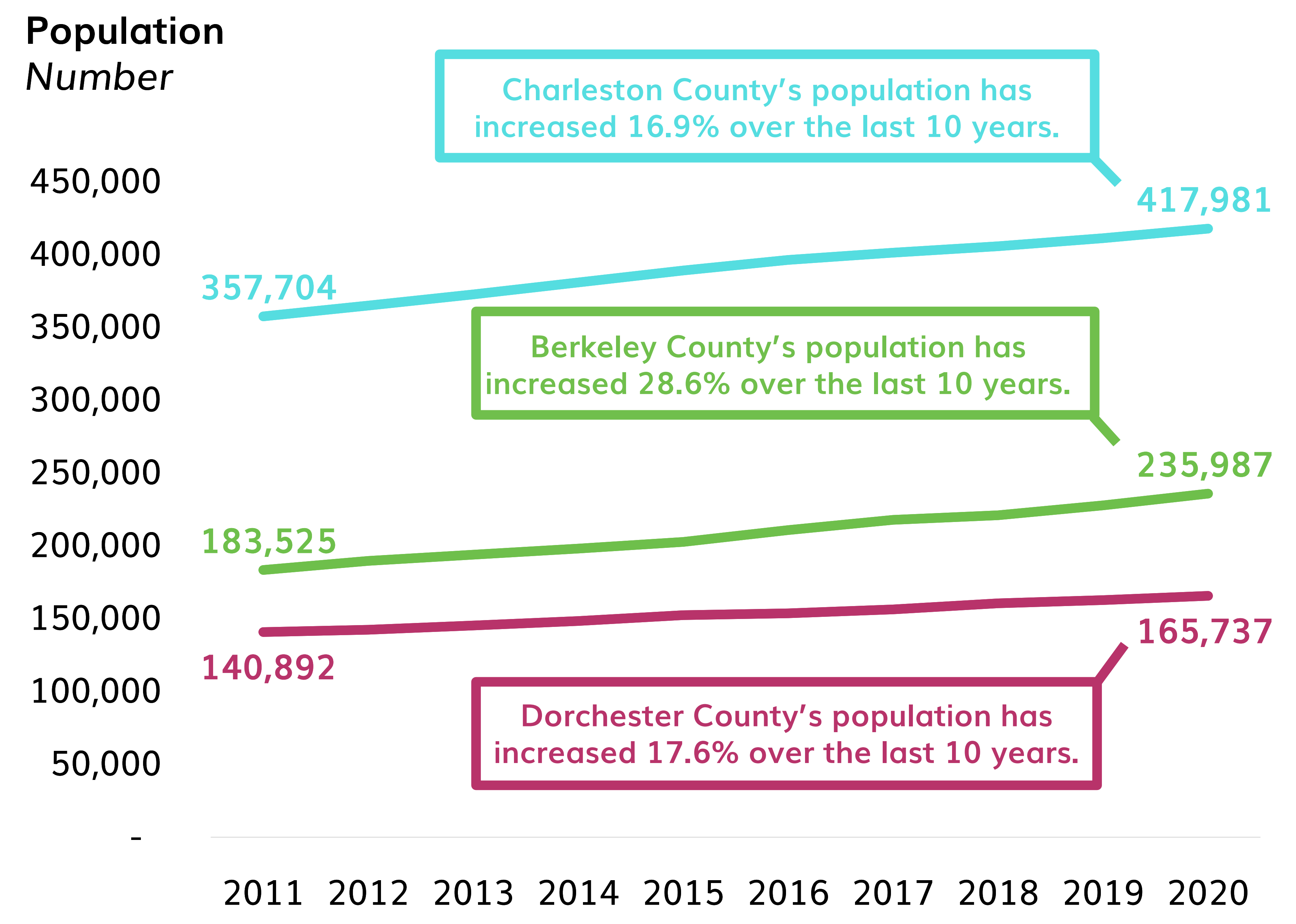

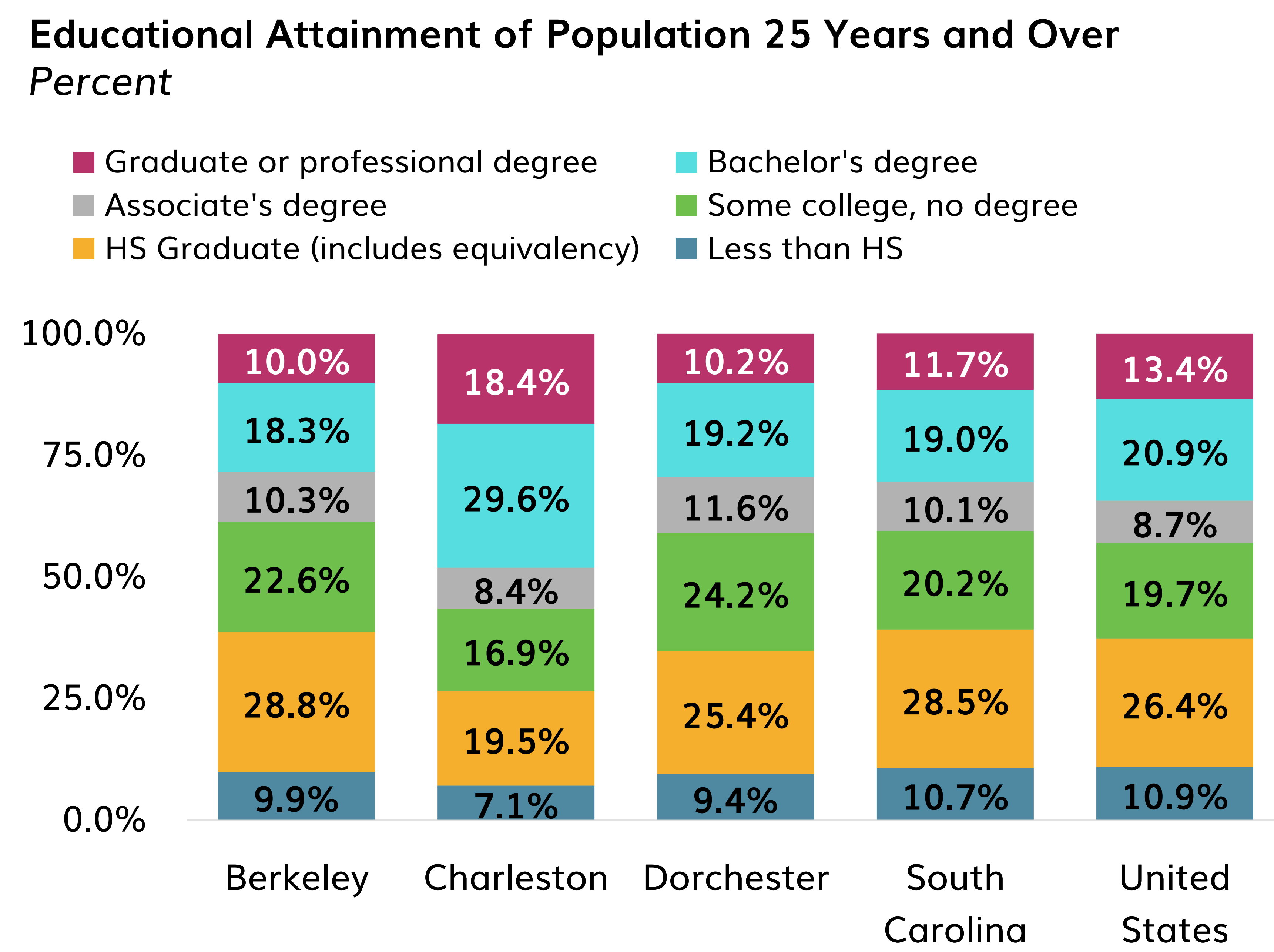

Population



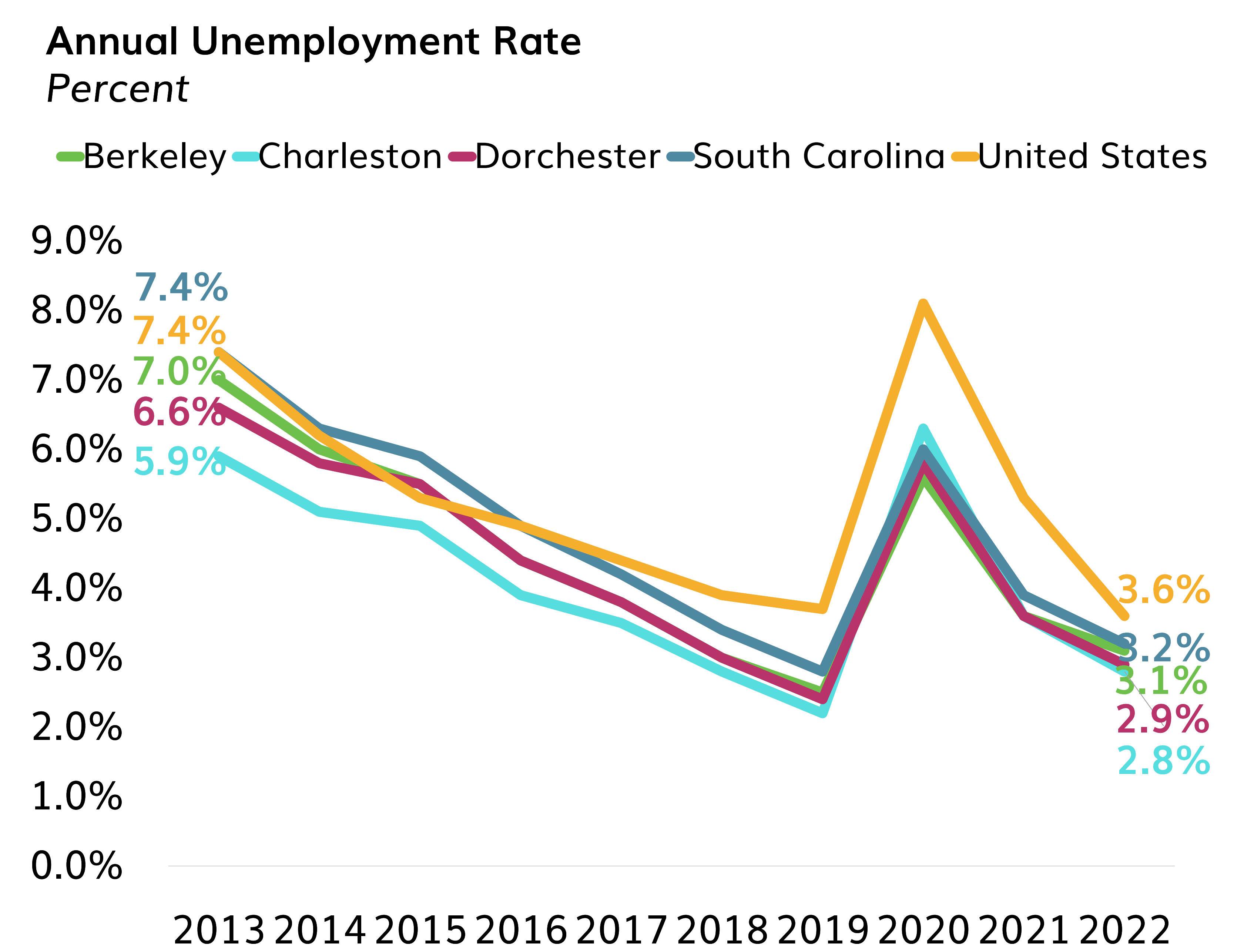

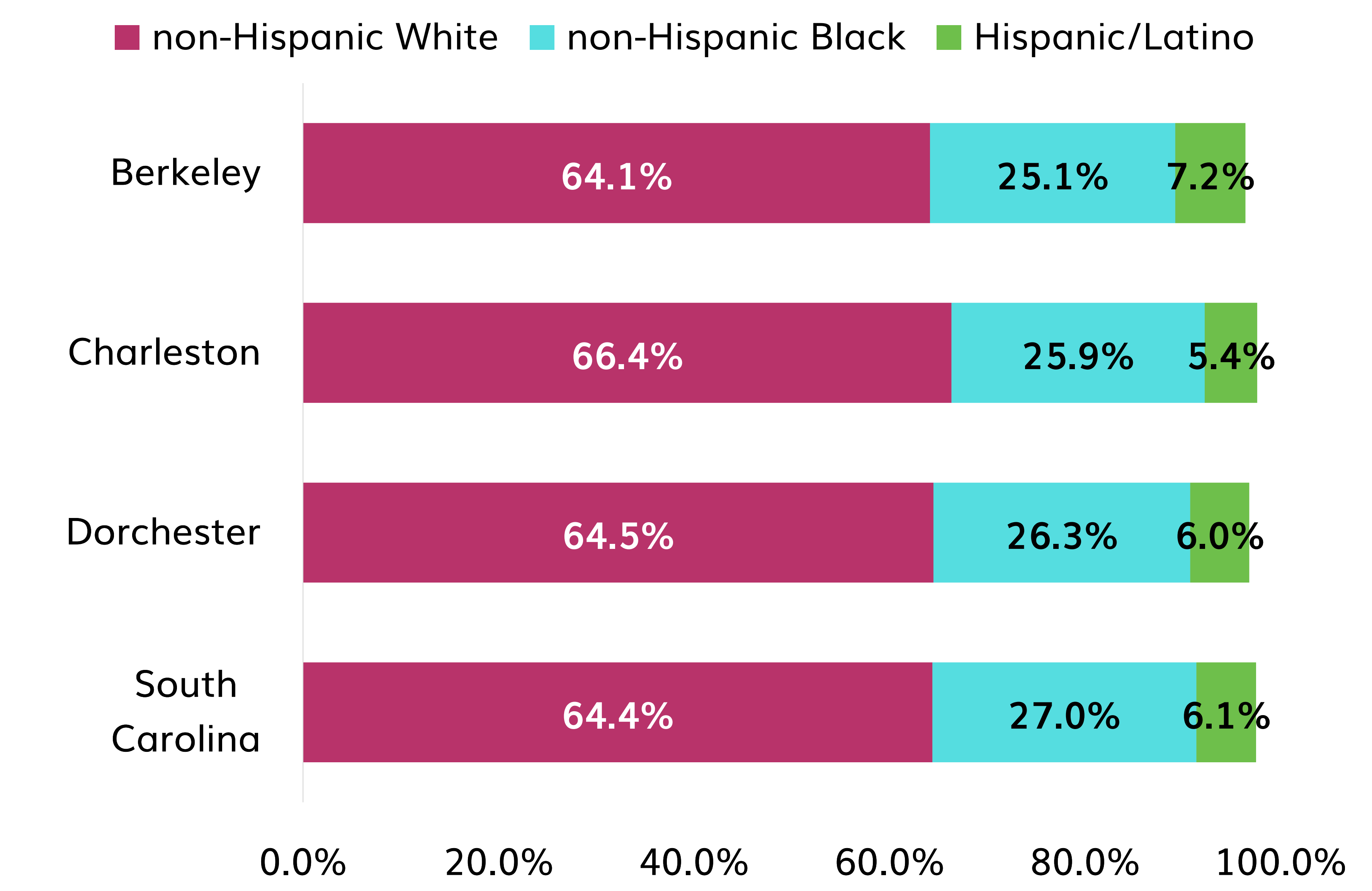

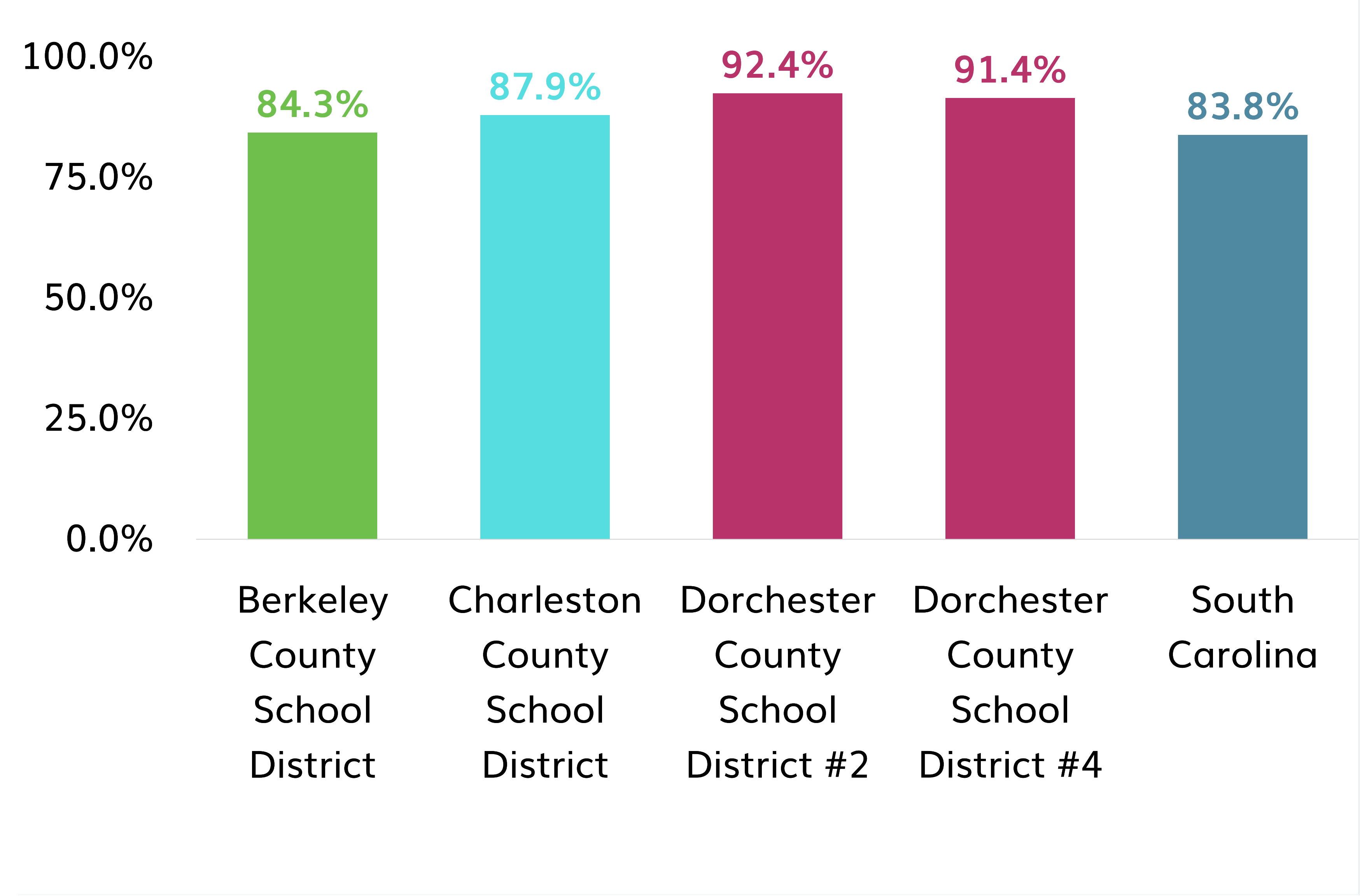

Population, by Race & Ethnicity



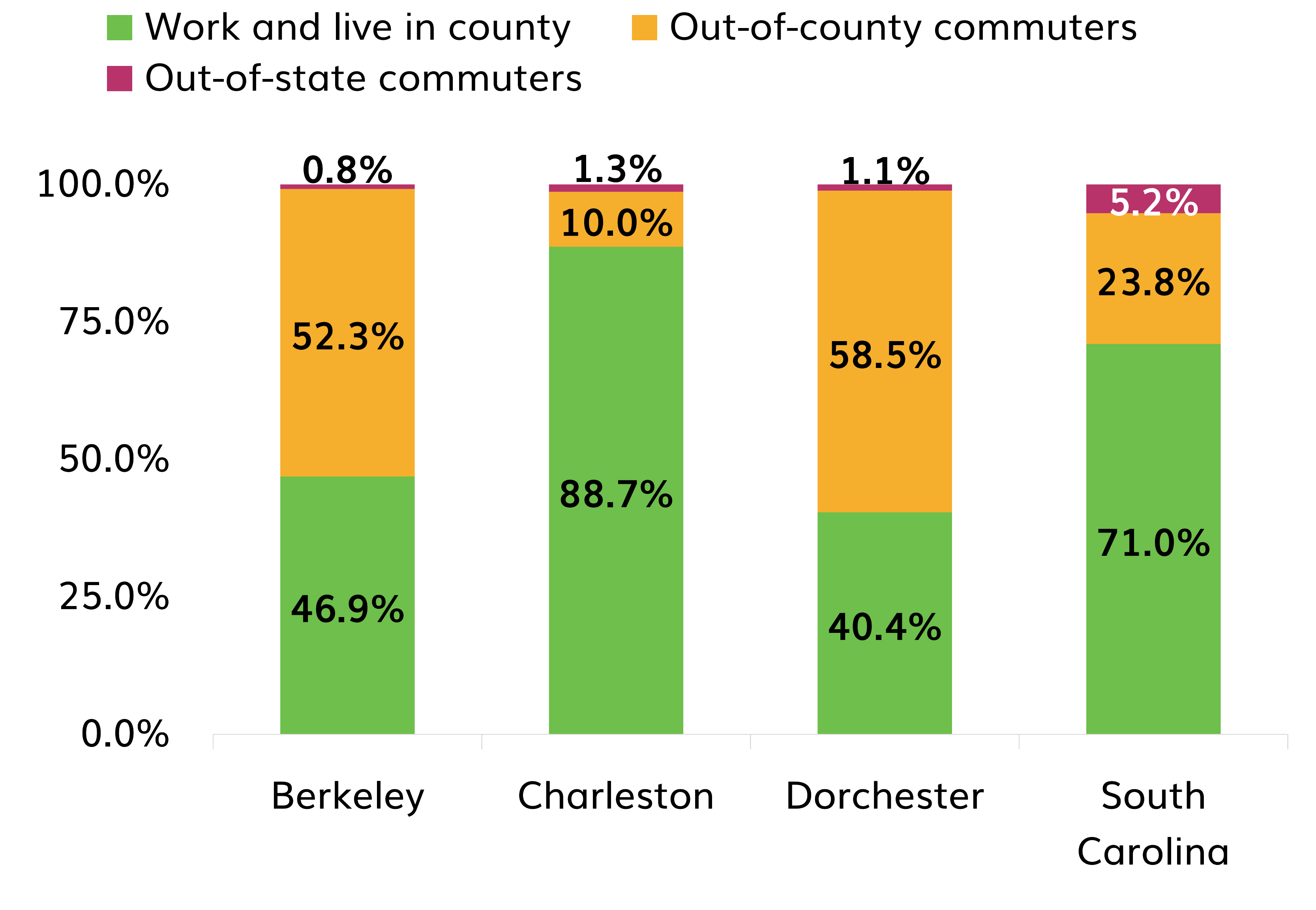

Commuting Patterns



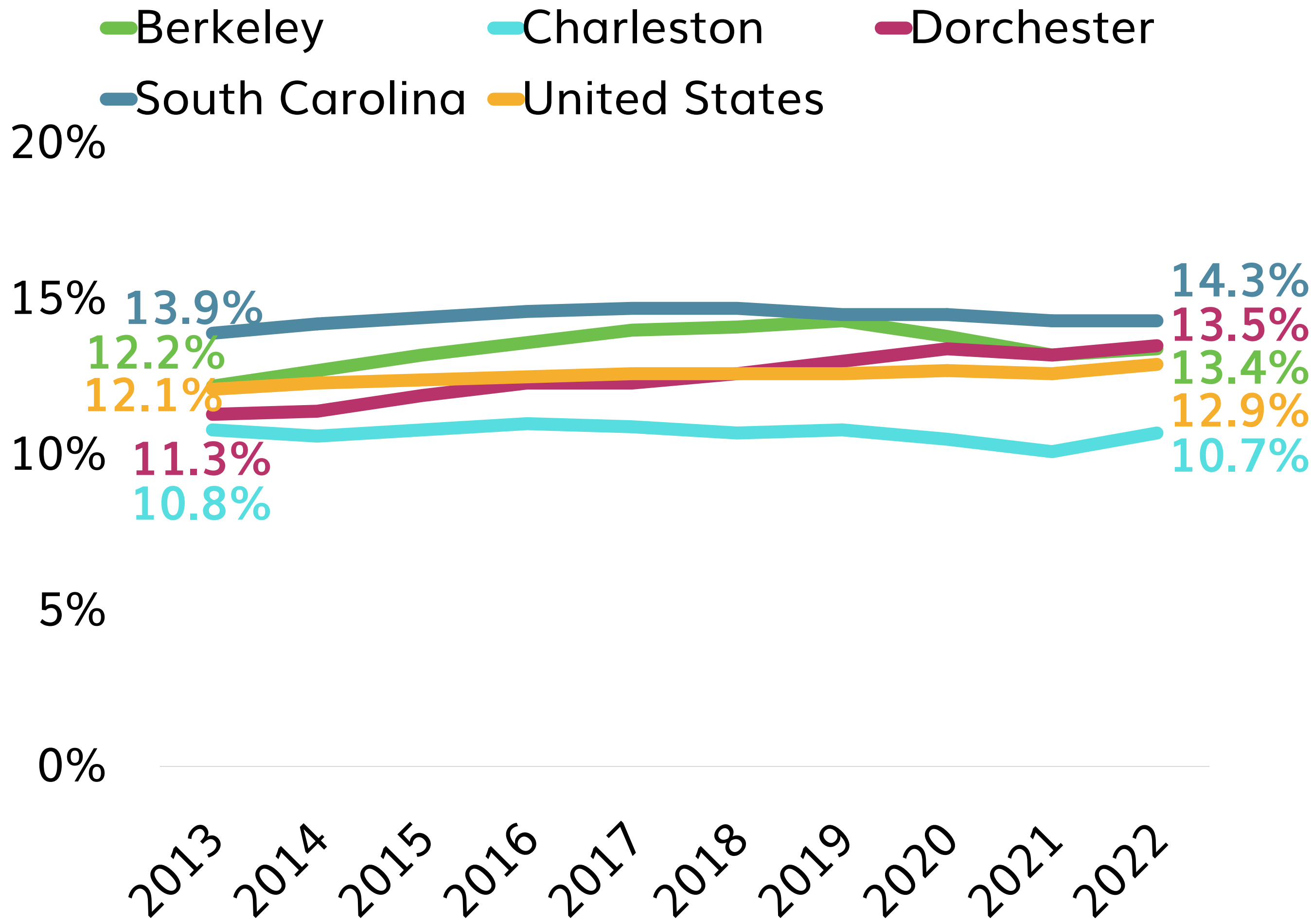

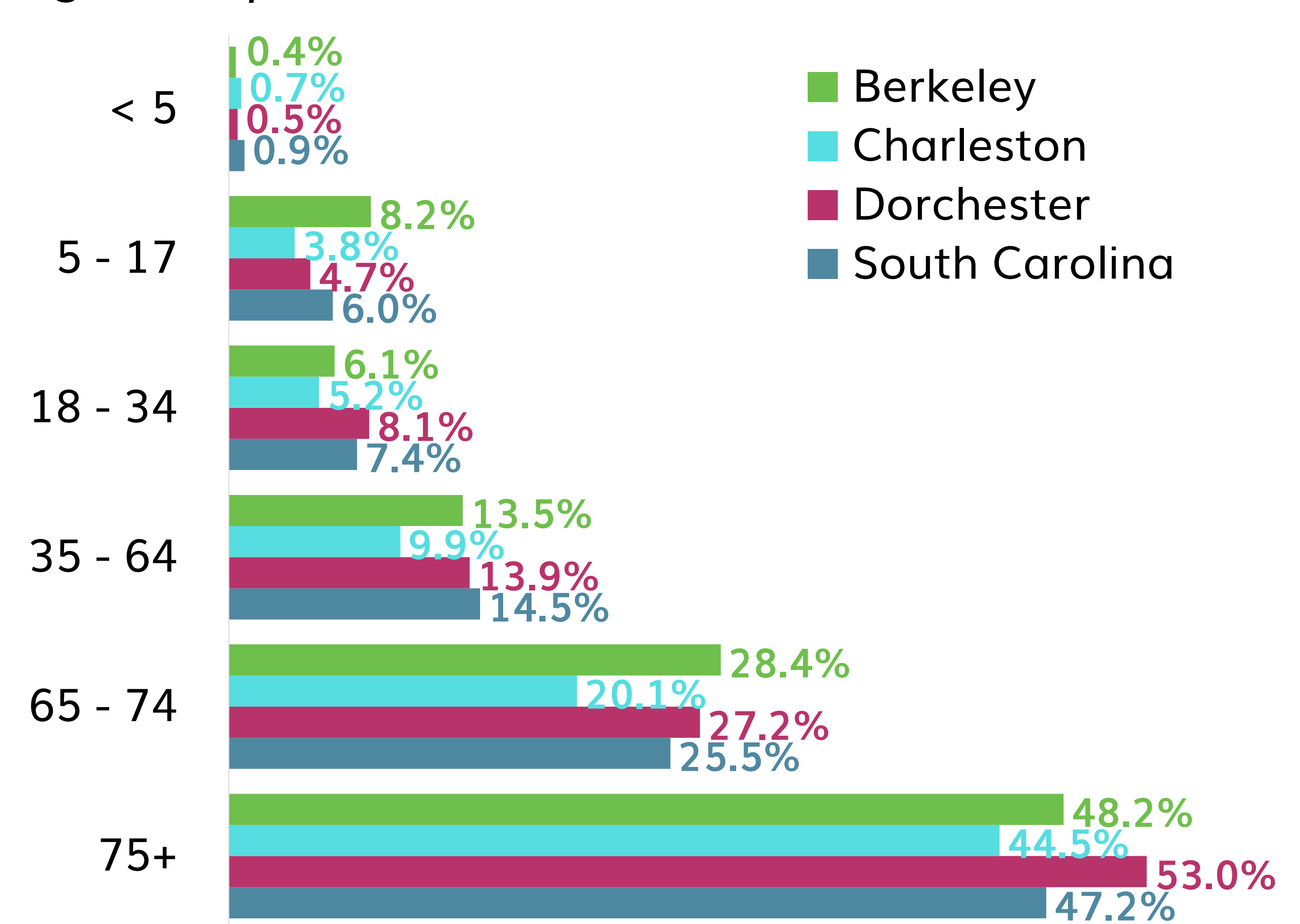

Population with a Disability

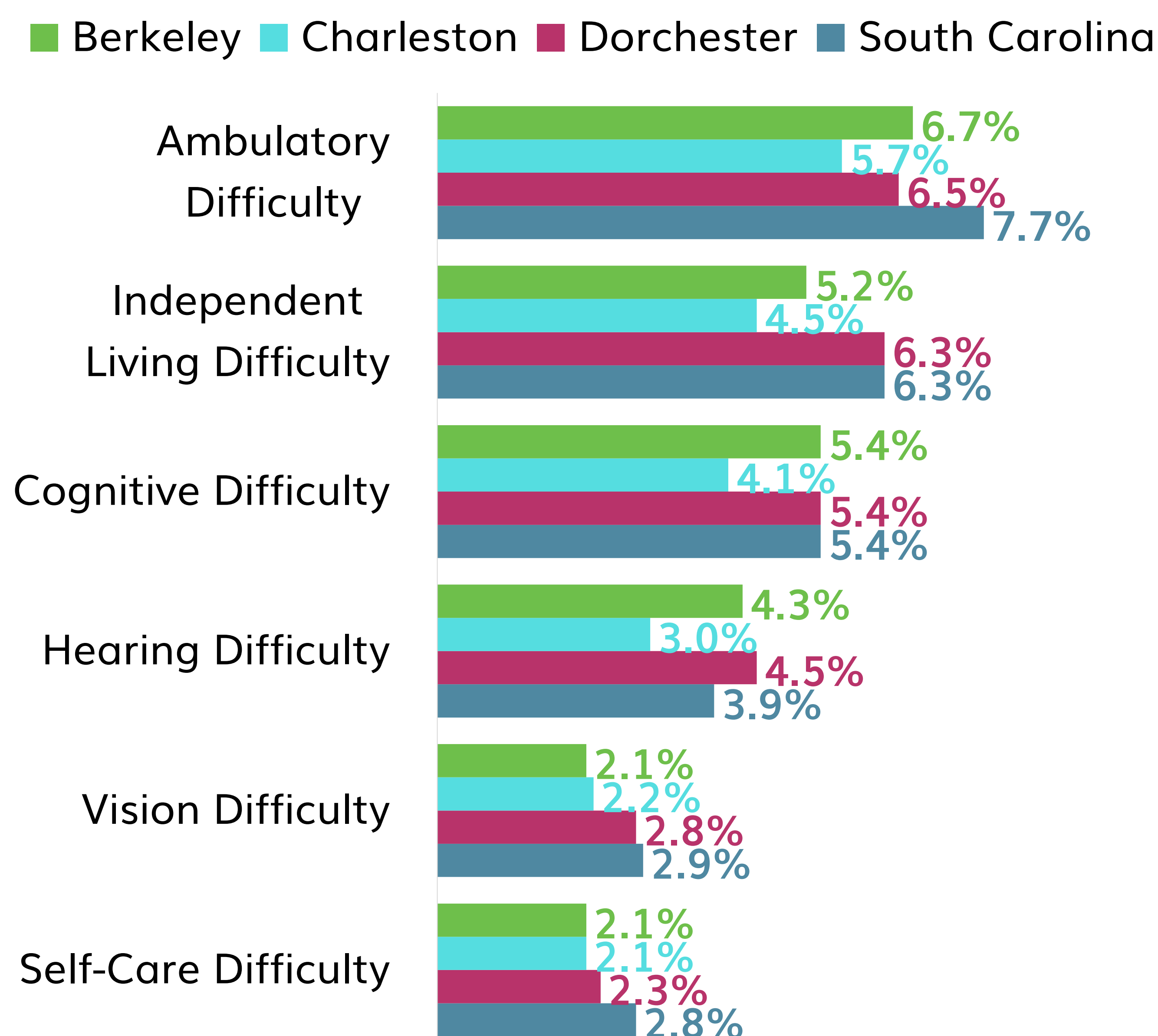
Age Group

Disability Type

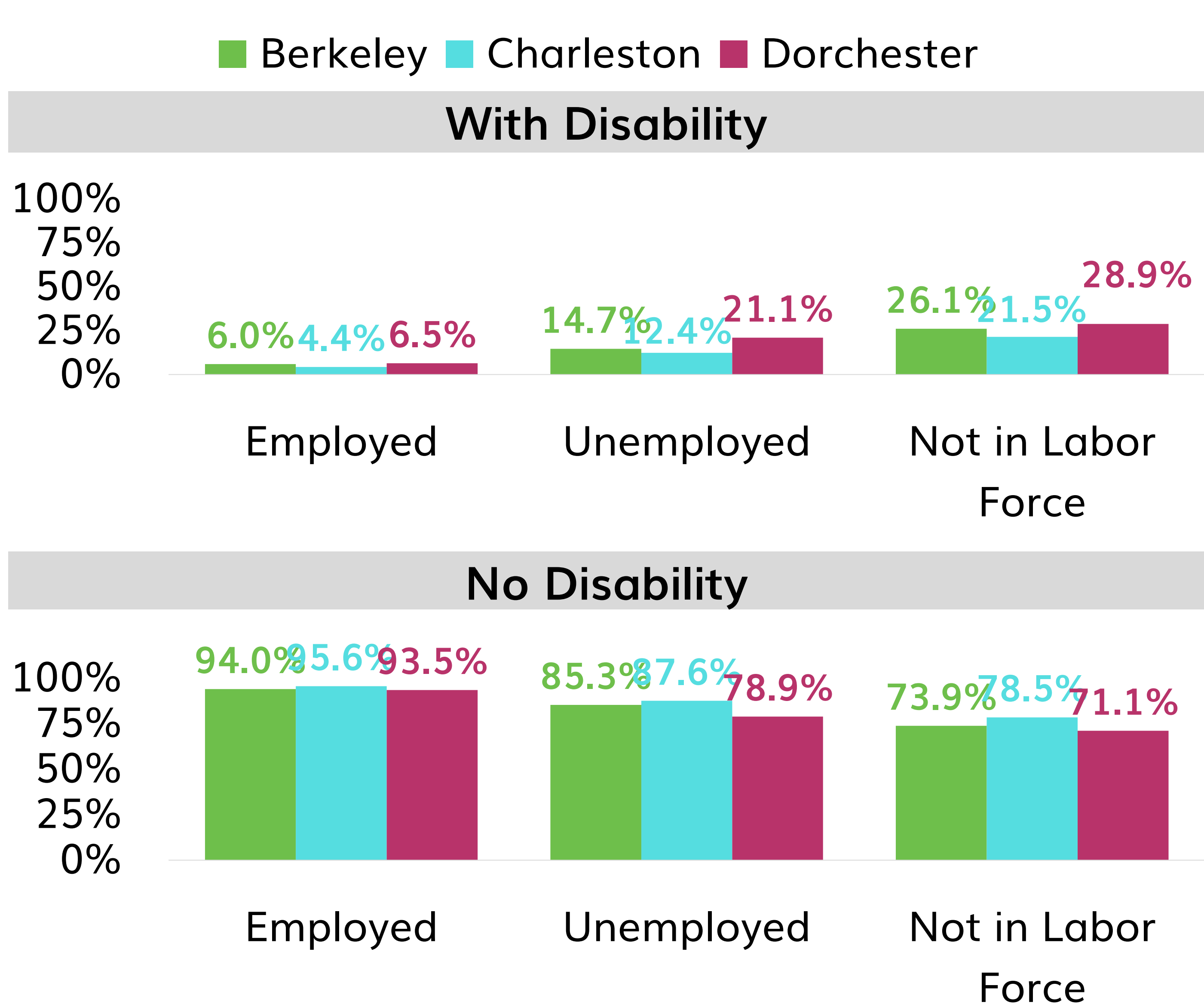

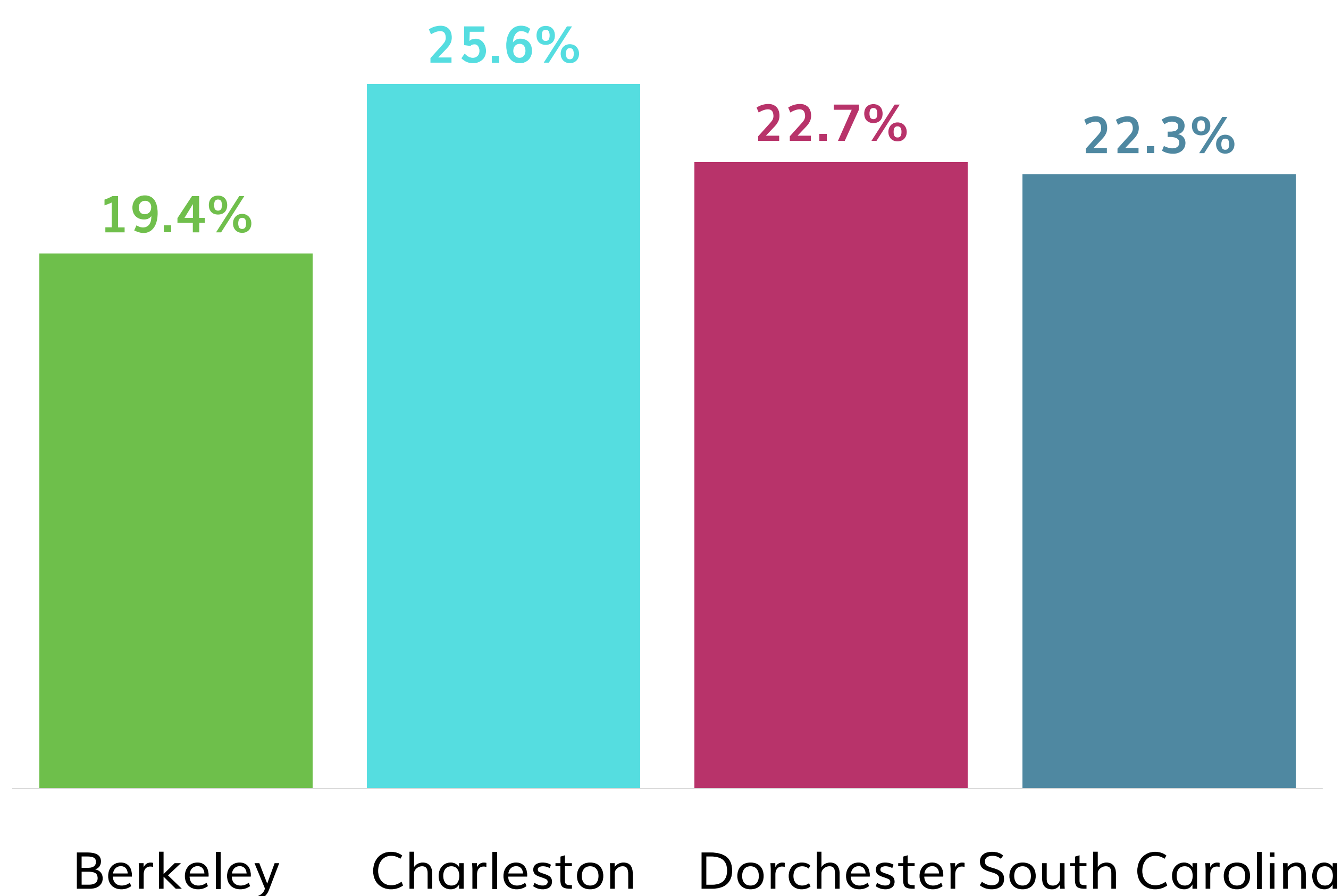

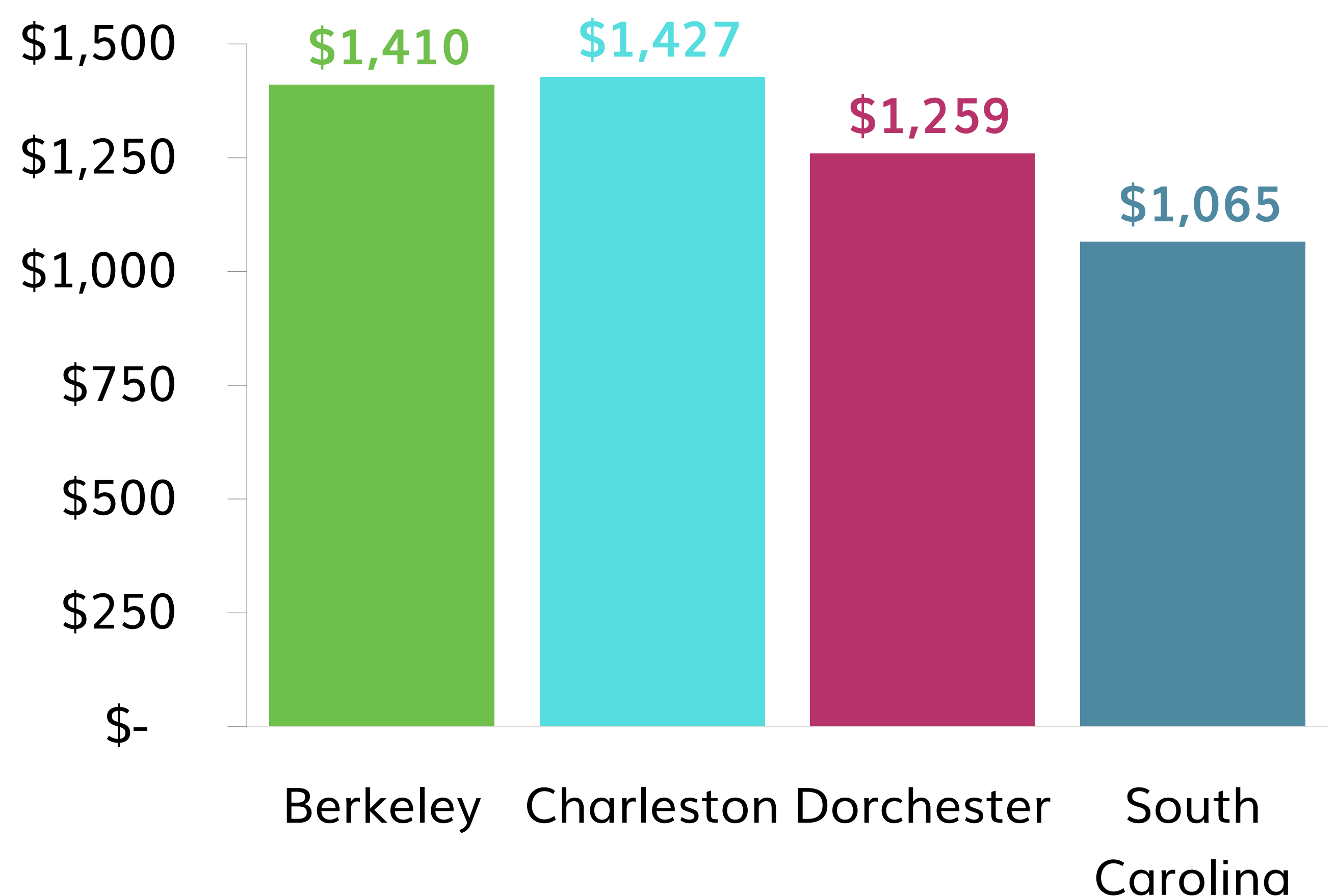

Percent**



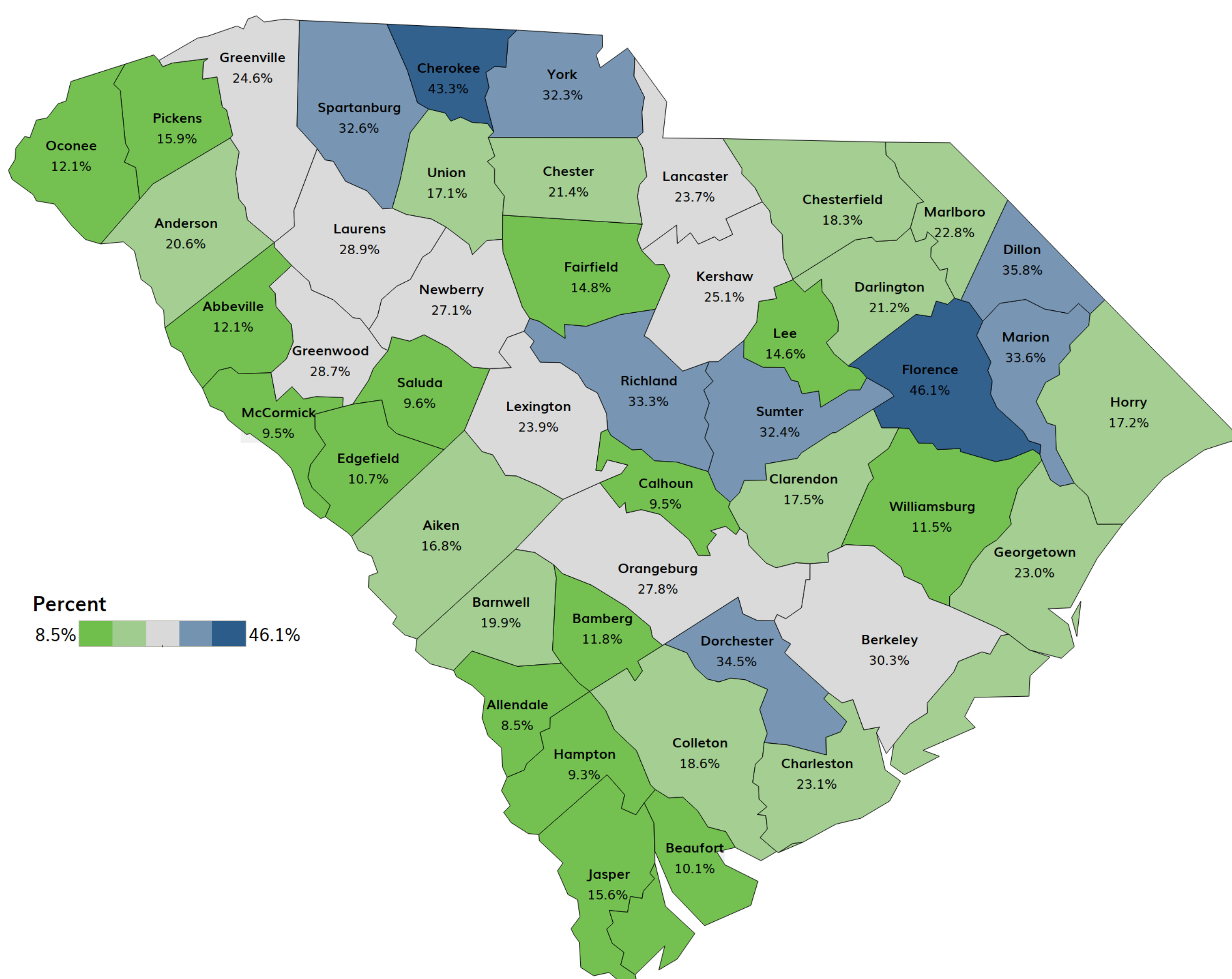
