Lowcountry Careers Collaborative (LCC) aims to boost the region's healthcare workforce by offering residents free training for entry-level healthcare roles with quality career pathways.

Eligibility

- Must be a resident of Berkeley, Charleston, Dorchester counties.
- High School Diploma or GED
- There are no income requirements for tuition assistance.

Supportive Services

LCC students will work one-on-one with a career coach to develop a training and employment plan that matches their career goals. Additional services available to our students include:

- Resume and interview counseling;
- Cost of exam fees;
- Cost of uniforms;
- Financial literacy training;
- Job placement services;
- Childcare subsidies*; and
- Transportation support*.

Patient Care Technician (PCT) direct hire

Description

PCTs assist medical staff by providing direct personal care for patients –this may include feeding, cleaning, and other tasks to ensure patients are comfortable.

CMAs stage patients in preparation to see providers – this may include verifying patient information and other administrative or clinical duties to a support quality patient experience.

Description

This position is responsible for sterilizing medical equipment to ensure instruments are free of contaminants prior to use for patient care.
