## WHO IS ALIEE?

ALICE ${ }^{\circledR}$,
an acronym for Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed,
is a new way of defining and understanding the struggles of households that earn above the Federal Poverty Level, but not enough to afford basic necessities.

## What is the ALCE Threshold?

Households with income above the Federal Poverty Level but below the basic cost of living.

## ALICE THRESHOLD:

The average income needed to afford the Household Survival Budget.
(ALICE + Federal Poverty Level = ALICE Threshold)
